

TOWN PLANNING ORDINANCE (Chapter 131)

APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF PLAN

Pursuant to section 12A(6) of the Town Planning Ordinance (the Ordinance), the application(s) for amendment of plan made under section 12A(1) of the Ordinance as set out in the Schedule below are available for public inspection during normal office hours at the following locations -

- (i) the Planning Enquiry Counter, 17th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong;
- (ii) the Planning Enquiry Counter, 14th Floor, Sha Tin Government Offices, 1 Sheung Wo Che Road, Sha Tin, New Territories; and
- (iii) the Tsuen Wan and West Kowloon District Planning Office, 27th Floor, Tsuen Wan Government Offices, 38 Sai Lau Kok Road, Tsuen Wan, New Territories (only for application(s) marked with asterisk (*) in the Schedule).

In accordance with section 12A(9) of the Ordinance, any person may make comment to the Town Planning Board (the Board) in respect of the application(s). The comment should state the application number to which the comment relates and should be made to the Secretary, Town Planning Board by hand, post (15th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong), fax (2877 0245 or 2522 8426) or e-mail (tpbpd@pland.gov.hk), or through the Board's website (<http://www.info.gov.hk/tpb/>) not later than the date specified in the Schedule.

Any person who intends to make comment is advised to read the "Town Planning Board Guidelines on Publication of Applications for Amendment of Plans, Planning Permission and Submission of Comments on Various Applications under the Town Planning Ordinance" for details. The Guidelines are available at the above locations, the Secretariat of the Board (15th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong) as well as the Board's website (<http://www.info.gov.hk/tpb/>).

In accordance with section 12A(12) of the Ordinance, any comment made to the Board will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at locations (i) to (iii) above until the Board has considered the application(s) in question under section 12A(16).

The location plan(s) and the gist(s) of the broad development parameters of the indicative development proposal(s) (if any) in support of the application(s) can be viewed at the above locations, the Secretariat of the Board and the Board's website.

Statement on Personal Data

The personal data submitted to the Board in any comment will be used by the Secretary of the Board and Government departments for the following purposes:

- (a) the processing of the application which includes making available the name of the person making the comment (hereafter known as "commenter") for public inspection when making available the comment for public inspection; and
- (b) facilitating communication between the "commenter" and the Secretary of the Board/Government departments in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance and the relevant Town Planning Board Guidelines.
