## APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT OF PLAN SUBMISSION OF FURTHER INFORMATION

Pursuant to section 12A(7)(b) of the Town Planning Ordinance (the Ordinance), the Town Planning Board (the Board) has published newspaper notice(s) of the application(s) for amendment of plan made under section 12A(1) of the Ordinance as set out in the Schedule below. In accordance with sections 12A(14)(c) and 12A(12) of the Ordinance, any comment made to the Board will be available for public inspection during normal office hours at locations (i) and (ii) above until the Board has considered the application in question under section 12A(16).
